- MEWP and HIAB tickets
- Clean driving license is essential
- Valid full LGV Class C driving licence would be advantageous but not essential.
- Any electrical qualifications would be advantageous but not essential
- Must be able to carry out a wide range of practical tasks including digging and the use of mechanical plant
- Must be able to demonstrate a knowledge of Health and Safety requirements
- Keen to learn, self motivated, willing to work outside and able to work with heights.
- Must have a flexible approach to your work environment.
- Willing to undertake work of a routine and repetitive nature.
- Must be willing to participate in out of hours emergency service

Main Tasks

- The installation of street lighting columns, street furniture and associated equipment.
- The removal of illuminated street furniture and associated signs.
- The maintenance and accurate completion all paperwork, job sheets and other relevant documentation is an essential function.
- To be compliant with all appropriate legislation with regarding highways illuminated street furniture and electrical installations.
- To ensure that all stated safety policies, procedures and instructions are adhered to and that all the necessary records and checks are maintained.
- To ensure that all works are adequately protected and the safety of the workforce, public and vehicles is maintained at all times.
- To be available for "out of hours" emergency call-out service as applicable.
- To participate in any relevant training to satisfy the requirements of the position. To undertake other duties of a similar nature as may be requested by management.
